

SLALOM CANOE / KAYAK NATIONAL CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE SCHEDULE OF SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS 2005/2006

Tier 1 scholarship holders only

The Canoe / Kayak Slalom National Centre of Excellence (NCE) at its discretion will provide to tier 1 athletes:

1. Support for individual initiatives as agreed with the NCE Head Coach or coach in consultation with the National Performance Director;
2. Priority access to suitable training facilities provided by the NCE or through other approved agencies;
3. Priority high performance coaching under the direction of the NCE Head Coach and coaches;
4. Priority travel and accommodation subsidies for NCE camps as determined by the NCE coaches and National Performance Director; and,
5. Direct athlete payment for individual competition, training and other expenses at the highest level within the tier structure as determined by the Head Coach in consultation with the National Performance Director.

Tier 1 and tier 2 scholarship holders

The Slalom Canoe / Kayak National Centre of Excellence (NCE) at its discretion will provide to tier 1 and tier 2 athletes:

1. Annual NCE water pass at Penrith Whitewater Stadium;
2. The loan of a competition canoe or kayak purchased by the NCE Program for use in competition and training for a period agreed with the Head Coach and National Performance Director;
3. Direct athlete payment for individual competition, training and other expenses as determined by the Head Coach in consultation with the National Performance Director;
4. Access to suitable training facilities provided by the NCE or through other approved agencies;
5. High performance coaching under the direction of the NCE Head Coach and coaches;
6. Fitness and strength testing/evaluation and training programs under the direction and supervision of qualified personnel;
7. Sports Medicine and Sports Science (SS/SM) services provided by the Australian Institute of Sports' and/or New South Wales Institute of Sports' practitioners or approved providers including Biomechanics, Nutrition, Sports Psychology, Physiology, Physiotherapy;
8. Additional SS/SM funding and/or services may be allocated at the discretion of the NCE coaches and National Performance Director for those athletes that demonstrate a critical need;
9. Performance reporting and supervision;

10. Travel and accommodation subsidies for NCE camps as determined by the NCE Head Coach in consultation with the National Performance Director;
11. Assistance through the AIS' ACE program with career and personal development, education and employment at NCE camps and access to ACE services delivered by your State Institute or Academy of Sport in your daily training environment;
12. Reimbursement of ACE approved education expenses as outlined in the AIS' ACE schedule (from time to time);
13. Medical treatment, either by AIS medical practitioners and/or NCE approved external medical providers, where available for injury or illness which occurred during a designated NCE activity; and,
14. A "gap" rebate associated with payment for scheduled medical services required for injury or illness which has occurred during a designated NCE activity (as per Commonwealth Schedule of Medical Benefits) which private health insurance does not cover.

Tier 3 scholarship holders

The Slalom Canoe / Kayak National Centre of Excellence (NCE) at its discretion will provide to tier 3 athletes:

1. Annual NCE water pass at Penrith Whitewater Stadium;
2. Access to suitable training facilities provided by the NCE or through other approved agencies;
3. High performance coaching under the direction of the NCE Head Coach and coaches;
4. Fitness and strength testing/evaluation and training programs under the direction and supervision of qualified personnel as agreed with NCE Head Coach/coach and the relevant service provider;
5. Sports Medicine and Sports Science (SS/SM) services provided by the Australian Institute of Sports' and/or New South Wales Institute of Sports' practitioners or approved providers including Biomechanics, Nutrition, Sports Psychology, Physiology, Physiotherapy as agreed with NCE Head Coach/coach and the relevant service provider;
6. Additional SS/SM funding and/or services may be allocated at the discretion of the NCE coaches and National Performance Director for those athletes that demonstrate a critical need;
7. Performance reporting and supervision;
8. Travel and accommodation subsidies for NCE camps as determined by the NCE Head Coach in consultation with the National Performance Director;
9. Assistance through the AIS' ACE program with career and personal development, education and employment at NCE camps and access to ACE services delivered by your State Institute or Academy of Sport in your daily training environment; and,
10. Medical treatment, either by AIS medical practitioners and/or NCE approved external medical providers, where available for injury or illness which occurred during a designated NCE activity.

Additional benefits to NCE Scholarship holders

In addition to the benefits detailed above, state institutes at their discretion may provide their own specific benefits (eg. financial assistance for training and competition expenses).

- Other SIS/SAS athletes – administered through relevant SIS/SAS programs and documented in state specific agreement.
