This Supplement is to be read in conjunction with the General [Selection Procedures Bylaw](#).

## 1. EVENTS

- 1.1 The events for which teams representing Australia and AC will be selected in the Discipline of Marathon Canoeing in the year 2010 are:
- (a) 2010 ICF World Championships to be held at Banyolas, Spain, 23<sup>rd</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> September 2010
  - (b) 2010 ICF Junior World Championships to be held at Banyolas, Spain, 23<sup>rd</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> September 2010
  - (c) 2010 ICF Under 23 K1 World Championships to be held at Banyolas, Spain, 23<sup>rd</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> September 2010
  - (d) 2010 ICF Marathon events that require Australian Canoeing endorsement for entry.

## 2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1 The closing date for receiving nominations for selection to the Australian Canoe Marathon Team, as required by clause 5.1 of the AC General Selection Procedures Bylaw, is 26 March 2010.
- 2.2 These criteria may be amended or supplemented by the Board of AC in its absolute discretion from time to time. AC shall provide as much notice of such change as is possible to all affected Athletes, [Member State Associations](#) and others as determined by the Board in accordance with clauses 3.2 and 3.3 of the Selection Procedures Bylaw.

## 3. DEFINITIONS

In these Criteria, the following words have the following respective meanings:

<b>“General Selection Procedures Bylaw”</b>	means the Bylaw adopted by the Board of AC that governs the selection of Athletes to Australian Canoeing Teams.
<b>“Junior Team”</b>	means the World Junior Championships, Banyolas, Spain, 23 <sup>rd</sup> – 26 <sup>th</sup> September, 2010 for Athletes born Between 1992 and 1995.
<b>“Under 23”</b>	means an Athlete born on or after January 1, 1987

Words not defined in these Criteria have the meaning ascribed to them in the [Constitution](#) of AC or the Selection Procedures Bylaw unless a contrary meaning appears from the context.

## 4. SELECTION EVENTS

- 4.1 The following events are the Selection Events for the Team to compete in the 2010 World ICF World Championships to be held at Banyolas, Spain, Clause 1.1(a). An athlete or crew must compete in the event for which they wish to be considered.

(a) 2010 Australian Canoe Marathon Championships (singles event) on 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2010 at West Lakes, Adelaide, South Australia

(b) 2010 Australian Canoe Marathon Championships (doubles event), on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 at West Lakes, Adelaide, South Australia

4.2 The following events are the Selection Events for the Team to compete in the 2010 ICF Under 23 K1 World Championships to be held at Banyolas, Spain, Clause 1.1(c). An athlete must compete in the event for which they wish to be considered.

(a) 2010 Australian Marathon Canoeing Championships (singles event) on 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2010 at West Lakes, Adelaide, South Australia

(b) 2010 Australian Marathon Canoeing Championships (doubles event) on 4<sup>th</sup> April 2010 at West Lakes, Adelaide, South Australia

4.3 The Following events are the Selection Events for the Team to compete in the 2010 ICF Junior World Championships to be held at Banyolas, Spain, Clause 1.1 (b). An athlete must compete in the event for which they wish to be considered.

(a) 2010 Australian Marathon Canoeing Championships (singles event) on 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2010 at WestLakes, Adelaide, South Australia

(b) 2010 Australian Marathon Canoeing Championships (doubles event) on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 at Westlakes, Adelaide, South Australia

Junior Athletes seeking selection must compete in the Under 18 Classes at the Selection Events.

4.4 To be selected for the Team to compete in the 2010 World Championships, Senior, Junior, and Under 23, an athlete must be free to tour with the Team from the 16<sup>th</sup> of September to the 27<sup>th</sup> of September 2010.

## 5. SELECTION CRITERIA FOR 2010 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS IN BANYOLAS, SPAIN, 23<sup>RD</sup> – 26<sup>TH</sup>, SEPTEMBER, 2010

5.1 The Selection Panel appointed by the Board of AC pursuant to clause 4.1 of the Selection Procedures By-Law will select a maximum of two (2) Athletes or Crews in each of the following Classes to the Team:

- (a) Senior Men's K1
- (b) Senior Men's K2
- (c) Senior Men's C1
- (d) Senior Men's c2
- (e) Senior Women's K1
- (f) Senior Women's K2
- (g) Under 23 Men's K1
- (h) Under 23 Women's K1
- (i) Junior Men's K1
- (j) Junior Men's K2

- (k) Junior Men's C1
- (l) Junior Men's C2
- (m) Junior Women's K1
- (n) Junior Women's K2

5.2 Subject to Clause 5.11 a Senior Athlete will be selected in K1 from the nominated Athletes if they win the applicable K1 Class at the Selection Event, or if they finish within two percent (2%) of the winning Senior K1 time. Should more than two (2) Athletes satisfy this clause, the highest placed Athletes will be selected.

5.3 Subject to Clause 5.11, a Junior Athlete will be selected in K1 from the nominated Athletes if they win the applicable K1 Class at the Selection Event, or if they finish within three percent (3%) of the winning Junior K1 time. Should more than two (2) Athletes satisfy this clause, the highest placed Athletes will be selected.

5.4 Subject to Clause 5.11, a Senior Crew will be selected in K2 from the nominated Crews if they win the applicable K2 Class at the Selection Event, or if the Crew finishes within two percent (2%) of the winning Senior Crews' time. Should more than two (2) Crews satisfy this clause, the highest placed Crews will be selected.

5.5 Subject to Clause 5.11, a Junior Crew will be selected in K2 from the nominated Crews if they win the applicable K2 Class at the Selection Event, or if the Crew finishes within three percent (3%) of the winning Junior Crews' time. Should more than two (2) Crews satisfy this clause, the highest placed Crews will be selected.

5.6 Subject to Clause 5.11, an Under 23 Athlete will be selected in K1 from the nominated Athletes if they win the applicable K1 class at the Selection Event, or if they finish within two and a half percent (2.5%) of the winning Under 23 K1 time. Should more than two (2) Athletes satisfy this clause, the highest placed Athletes will be selected.

5.7 Subject to Clause 7.11, A Senior Athlete will be Selected from the nominated Athletes in C1 if they:

- (a) Win the applicable C1 Class at the Selection Event or finish within two percent (2%) of the winner's time; and
- (b) Finish within 7% of the winning time for the Women's K1 at the Selection Event.

Should more than two Athletes satisfy clauses (a) and (b), the highest placed Athletes will be selected.

5.8 Subject to Clause 5.11, A Junior Athlete will be Selected from the nominated Athletes in C1 if they:

- (a) Win the applicable C1 Class at the Selection Event or finish within three percent (3%) of the winner's time; and,
- (b) Finish within ten percent (10%) of the winning time for the Junior Women's K1 at the Selection Event.

Should more than two Athletes satisfy clauses (a) and (b), the highest placed Athletes will be selected.

5.9 Subject to clause 5.11 a Senior Crew will be Selected in C2 from the nominated Crews if they:

- (a) Win the applicable C2 Class at the Selection Event or finish within two percent (2%) of the winning time; and
- (b) Finish within seven percent (7%) of the winning time for the Women's K2 at the Selection Event.

Should more than two Crews satisfy clauses (a) and (b), the highest placed Crews will be selected.

5.10 Subject to Clause 5.11, a Junior Crew will be selected from the nominated Crews in C2 if they:

- (a) Win the applicable Junior C2 class at the Selection event or finish within three percent (3%) of the winning Junior C2 time; and
- (b) Finish within ten percent (10%) of the winning time for the Junior Women's K2 Class at the Selection event.

Should more than two (2) Crews satisfy clauses (a) and (b), the highest placed Crews will be selected.

5.11 If a nominated Athlete qualifies in more than one event, then the Selectors in their sole and absolute discretion, and after discussion with the Athlete, will determine the class, or classes, in which the Athlete will participate.

5.12 Where as a result of Clause 6.2 to 6.10 or for some other reason the maximum of two Athletes/Crew are not selected to the Team to compete in a class, then the Selection Panel MAY in its sole and absolute discretion, select to the Team from the nominated Athletes/Crews additional Athletes/Crews who have met the Selection Criteria.

5.13 In the selection of Junior Athletes/Crews, where there are not enough nominated Athletes in a class to select both singles and doubles, the Selection Panel, MAY, request Athletes to compete in both singles and doubles classes after consultation with the Athlete.

5.14 In both Junior and Senior selection for the World Championship Team, no nominated Athlete or Crews will be selected to fill a Class in which they have not met the required selection Criteria for that Class.

## 6. RESERVES.

6.1 Where the Selection Panel decides that it will select Reserve Athletes/Crews in accordance with Selection Procedures Bylaw 7.4, Selection Withdrawal, Reserve Athletes/Crews MAY be selected from within the World Championship Team Members to fill vacant team positions, after consultation with the Athlete/Crews.

## 7. EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES

For the purposes of determining whether an Athlete has met the requirements of this Selection Criteria Supplement Australian Canoeing will not have regard to any extenuating circumstances.
